<p>Winery Information: Aldeya taken from the Arabic for village. Finca Ayles, the estate dates back to the XII century when Monks first tended the vines. It also lays claim to being the birth place of the artist Goya. “Pago” is the highest status awarded to a winery under the Spanish system. It requires annual approval from regional, national and now European level.
