<p>Winery Information: Don Carlos Putruele, son of Italian immigrants, settled in “San Juan de la Frontera” in the 1950s and dedicated himself to his great passion of wine making when in 1958, he founded the winery Bodega Putruele in the Tulum Valley. 3 generations of the Putruele family have since been stewards of this stand out winery, guiding and growing it into the modern and forward thinking winery which exists today.
